Kiawah Island Men's Golf Association (KMGA)

The Kiawah Island Men's Golf Association (KMGA) is comprised of Governors Club men who enjoy golf. It provides members an opportunity to meet new Kiawah golfers and generate new friendships in a healthy competitive environment. A golf committee made up of volunteers governs KMGA. KMGA conducts the following events:

- Weekly Wednesday Blitz's (at reduced cart fees) rotating among all of the resort courses (Turtle, Cougar, Osprey, Oak Point and Ocean (twice annually)). Each game is played in a modified Stableford format (1 point for bogey, 2 for par, 4 for birdie, and 8 for eagle). A shotgun start is used. Members are assigned a point quota based on average scores earned on the particular course and tees played each week. Members are welcome to play the regular or Kiawah (senior) tees. Weekly games may be 4-man teams, 2-man teams, or individual play. Following each weekly blitz, members enjoy social interaction, beverages, and awarding of prizes. Prizes are provided by a \$10 contribution from each player.
- Annual Player of the Year (POY) contest. POY points are accumulated by participation and standing in blitzes, special events and major tournaments.
- Pro-Am in January (A Kiawah professional joins each blitz team)
- Member-Member Tournament in February
- Club Championship in March
- Member-Guest Tournament in October
- Interclub events with Seabrook, Wild Dunes, and the Kiawah Island Club
- Special events on an occasional basis including a Shamrock Tournament in March, a Senior (age-flighted) event in April, and a team match play tournament.
- Occasional social events and meetings where member inputs are sought on formats for future events.

Annual dues are collected in order to provide support for all special (non-blitz) events and to provide for a hole-in-one fund shared annually among members recording a hole-in-one during a KMGA event. With the exception of weekly blitzes and associated events, KMGA prizes are in the form of resort gift cards, which can be used for any Governor's Club expenses (golf fees, dining, merchandise, monthly bill payment).

For 2019, dues have been established by the golf committee at \$35. To join, please return the bottom portion of this form with a check payable to **KMGA**.
